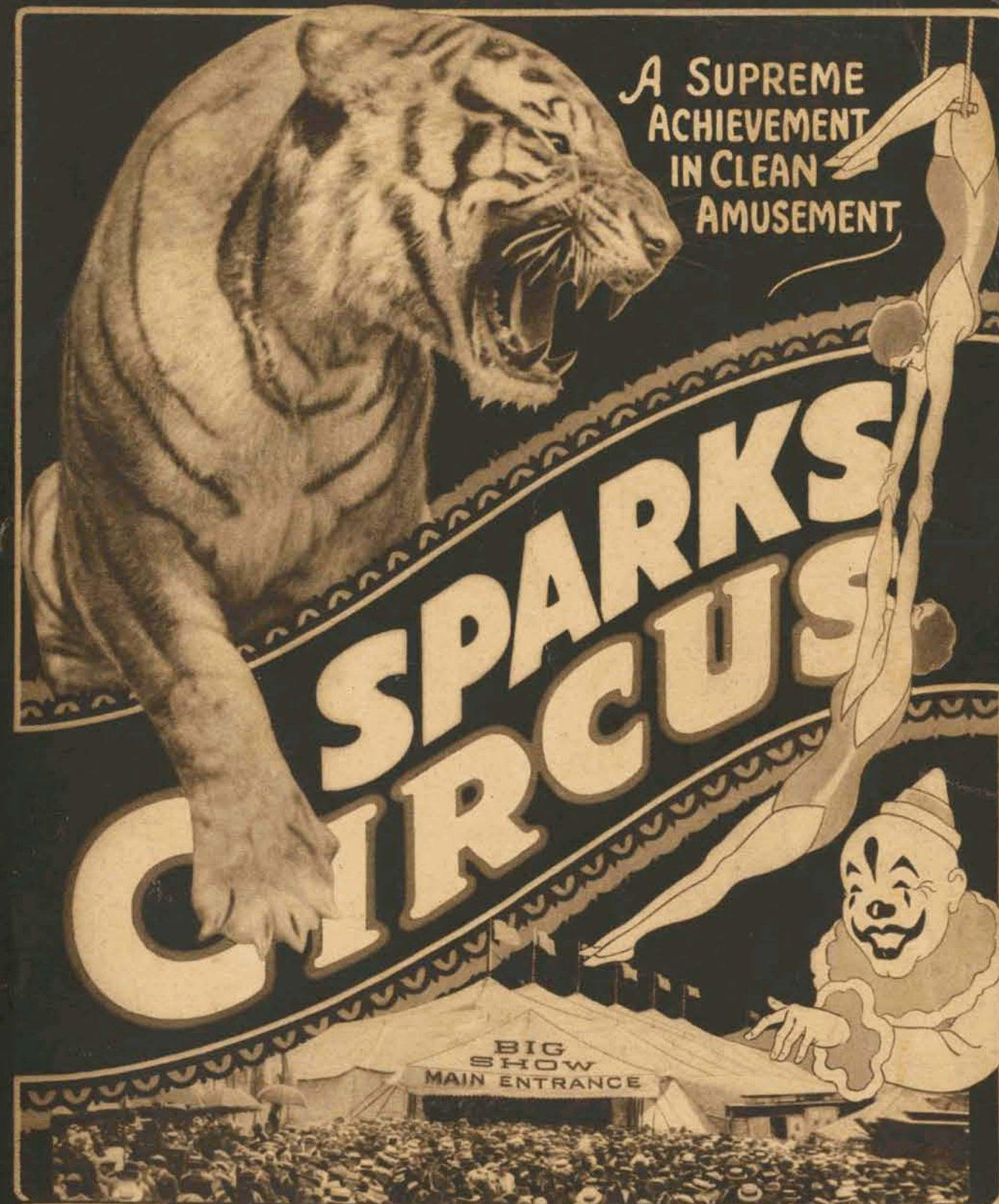

To Our Prospective Patrons

IN PRESENTING YOU THIS BOOKLET, announcing the coming of Sparks Circus to your community in the very near future, it is with great pride and pleasure, as well as truthfulness, that I make the following statement and guarantee, viz: That it is by far the best, largest and most sensational circus performance ever inaugurated under the Sparks banner. Having its humble beginning on a few wagons almost a half century ago, it now requires two long railway trains of double length steel cars for its transportation.

The entire circus equipment—trains, wagons, tents, paraphernalia, costumes and wardrobe, are all new this year. The horses and wild animals of all species and kinds have undergone the most rigid inspection, and only those in the very pink of physical condition have been retained. Every detail and item not measuring up to the highest standard has been discarded, to make room for only the best obtainable. These replacements, together with the vast enlargements in all departments, place the Sparks Circus in the very van of all tented amusements.

The program has been recently augmented by several new and stupendous features, notable among which is the newly imported display of trained wild beasts acquired by representatives of this organization in Europe, at tremendous cost. Wild animal experts all over the world unanimously agree that these groups of jungle beasts are the very finest ever subjugated by man. Fabulous salaries have induced many of the world's greatest arenic artists to affix their signatures to Sparks Circus contracts this season. Truly, our sole incentive in assembling this remarkable performance has been to obtain the best, regardless of expense.

Many new ideas have been adopted, both for the convenience and comfort of our patrons. Wherever attaches come in direct contact with the public they have been schooled in courtesy to the last degree, and the slightest complaint of their being

discourteous results in their immediate dismissal. Comfortable rest rooms (tents) have been provided for ladies and children, where an experienced maid will be in attendance at all times. Arrangements will be made in each city where the circus exhibits for the sale of tickets at one of the leading downtown stores, thus enabling the public to escape the throngs of waiting people at the ticket wagons, and purchase tickets at the same price as charged at the circus grounds.

To those who prefer to attend the night performance, I will give my personal guarantee that they will see the identical performance that is exhibited in the afternoon—not one feature being curtailed or omitted. Our tents are brilliantly lighted with a double system of illumination, including both electric and incandescent gasoline equipment, and these beautiful lights add much to the night performance.

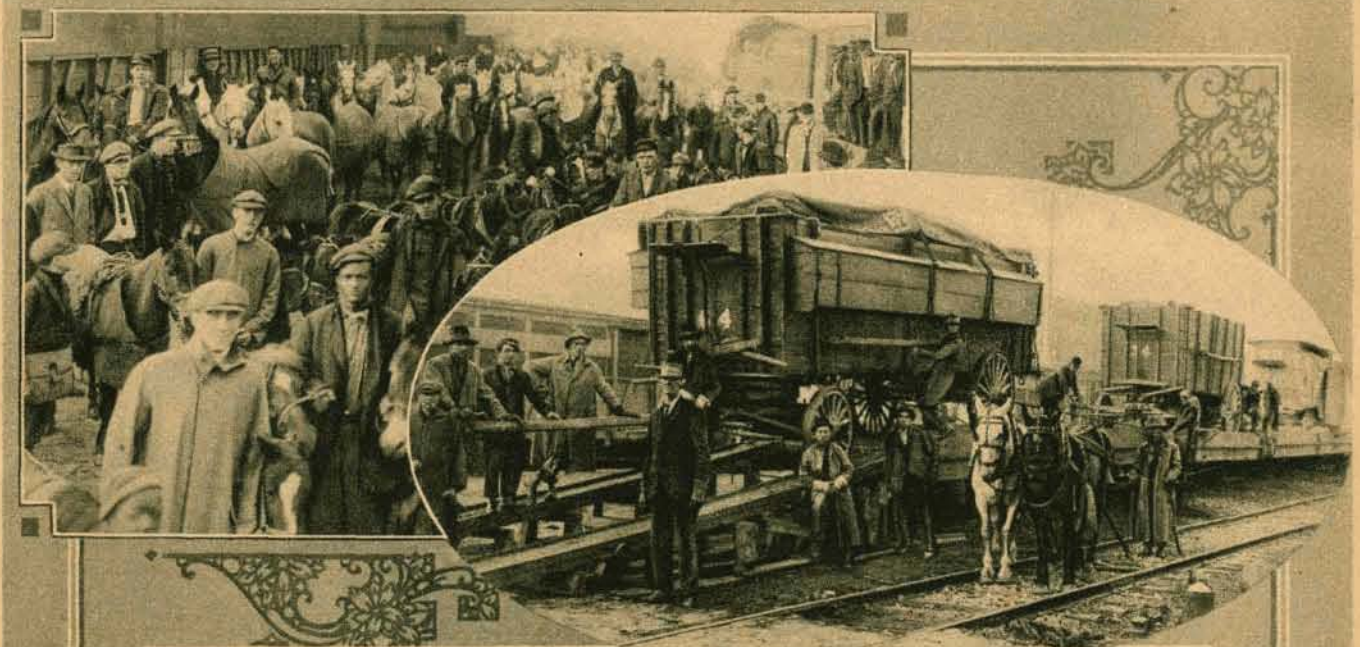

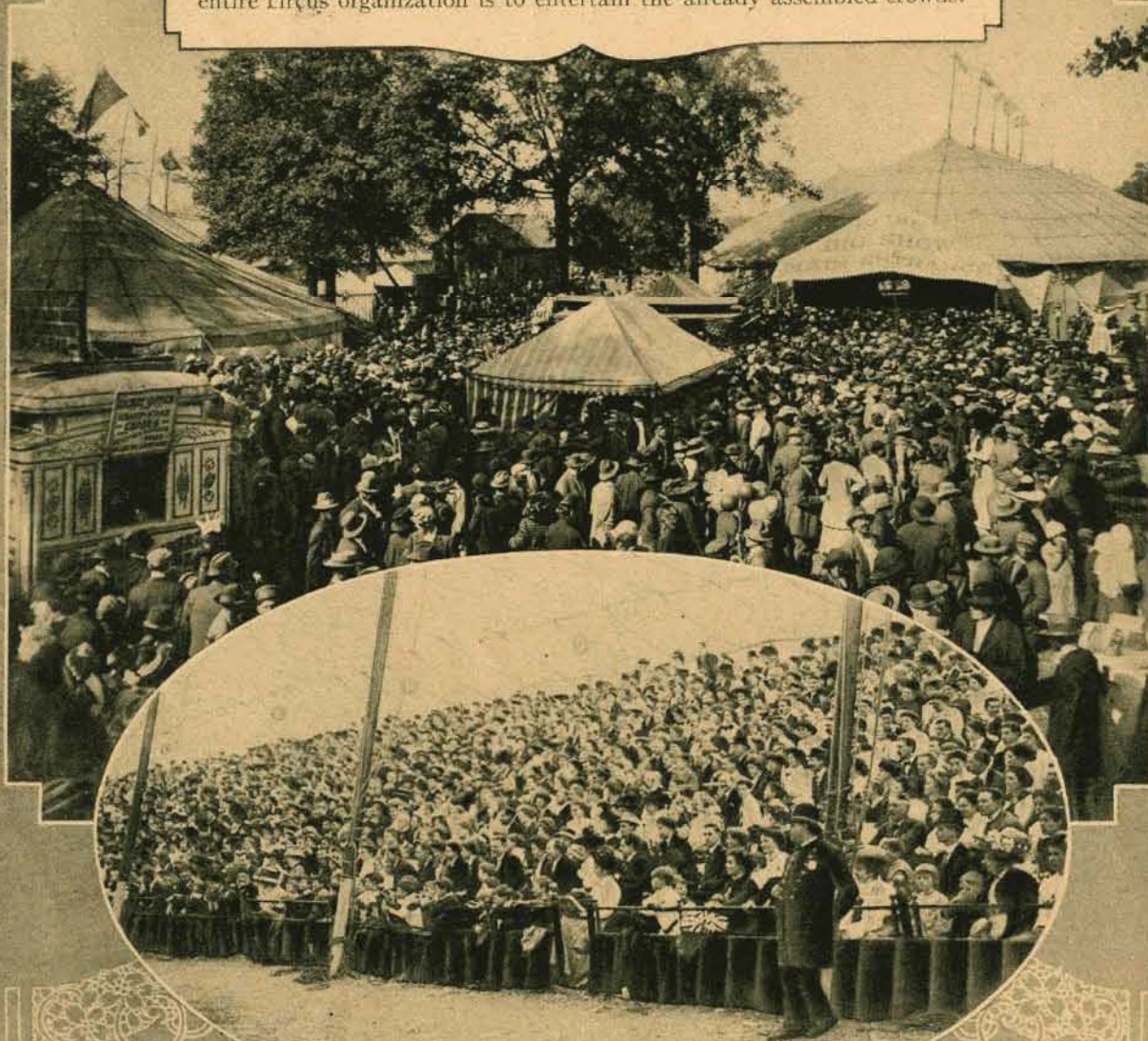
