Crackdown Underway

A campaign aimed at stopping out-of-state registration of vehicles was recently initiated by the California Dept. of Motor Vehicles. Officials estimate the State of California losses amount to millions of dollars a year because of the illegal practice.

Registration of vehicles owned by individuals and business firms are under investigation, according to the state officials. The California license fee is based on the value of the vehicle, as is the state's sales tax program.

Guadalajara, Mexico - Jan. 25 - The show had already been here four weeks when I caught the morning performance, and they still had one week to go. The big top was fronted by three large semis with metal banners. One had two windows for selling tickets and another had a center walk-through to enter the big top.

The circus also has a side show/menagerie top with four big cage wagons (bear, monkeys, baboon; hyena, lions; cougar, bear, wild cat; female baboon, condor, bear. Several small cages with smaller animals were directly in front of the large cages. Also in the tent were 3 midget horses plus a spotted donkey and three elephants.

The big top is approximately 150' round with a 40' center piece. It is of European construction and has full European seating, and one ring. The seats consist of the box seats, then 6 rows of chairs and 9 rows of blues.

Concessions are inside the tent and a photographer roams the stands to take pictures of the audience with Mickey Mouse. The performers entrance is the European style and six uniformed prop hands stand by to work. The band includes: 2 trumpets, 2 sax, a trombone, trap drums, bongo drums and organ.

Al Dawley, former Hanneford Family Circus ringmaster, will be with the Castle show and Rudy Bros. this season.

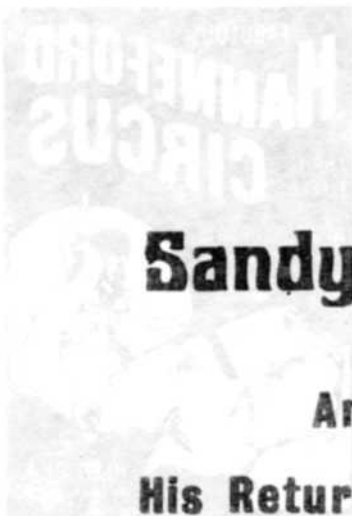

CRACKDOWN (Continued)

"The fact that a person or firm owns property in another state is not the determining factor," says the Motor Vehicle Dept. "A California resident or person employed in this state by an out-of-state firm has to register his vehicle in California. On a new vehicle, intended for use here, the registration here is mandatory. On an older vehicle the grace period for persons moving into California ends when the year ends or the plate expires."

Oregon, Nevada, Alabama and other Southern and Mid-west states are popular states in which to register vehicles because of their low fees. Other inducements include cheaper insurance and less smog control regulations, often resulting in the absence of such devices.

Firms operating in California on a part-time basis can pay a use tax for milage, or a pro-rated license fee plan is available. This plan offers an opportunity to buy licenses for vehicles only for the months of actual operation within the state.
